Duties and Responsibilities:

The **High River/Okotoks** Rotary Employment Partnership Coordinator is responsible for working with Rotary to identify potential employment opportunities; identify potential employees; provide ongoing support to the employer and employee; coordinate on-the-job supports with community agencies providing supported employment; facilitate relationships between employers and employees with and without developmental disabilities and attend Rotary functions.

Qualifications:

We are seeking an individual who is committed to the inclusion of persons with developmental disabilities in community life. This person must have direct experience in enabling individuals with developmental disabilities to participate inclusively in community life, ideally in employment. The candidate will have excellent inter-personal skills and a university or college education in disability studies or a related field. Equivalencies will be considered.

Working Conditions:

The position is **part-time**, with a salary to commensurate with experience. Only candidates selected for interviews will be contacted. Competition closes when a suitable candidate is found.
